

## Dress Code for Stewart School

1. Stewart Students should wear **clean**, comfortable and respectable clothing.
2. All students should dress for outside play every day according to the weather. Layers are recommended due to temperature changes throughout the day.
- \*Not having appropriate clothing is not a valid excuse for remaining inside during recess.
3. Gym shoes are required except on special dress days. We want all children to run and play at recess every day because their bodies and minds need this daily exercise.
4. All clothing must cover your midriff, front and back.
5. Shorts should be as long as the student's hands when arms and hands are extended down the side of the student's body and leg.
6. Tops may not be low-cut, see-through or spaghetti straps.
7. Shirts should have appropriate graphics.
8. For girls, shorts should be worn under dresses and skirts, since we often sit on the floor and move around a lot.

\*When clothing is worn that is deemed inappropriate, a staff member will explain to the student that the clothing should not be worn to school again. In the event that a student is wearing something offensive, parents will be called and asked to bring something more appropriate for school.

\*All removable clothing items must be labeled with the student's name. Unclaimed clothing items left at school will be placed in the lost and found in the gym. These will be displayed for students to claim throughout the school year. Anything left will be donated to a local charity.
